Events are: **22 Smallbore Rifle Target Shooting & Trap Shooting**

Entry Fees will be \$20.00 per Event and your Entry Fee will be collected at each Shoot.

(Entry Fee will cover cost of Ranges, Targets, Trap and YearEnd Awards)

There will be NO Jackpot at Individual Shoots, but there will be YearEnd Awards for Top Shooters.

Shooting Entries will be done 10 days prior to shoot/rodeo and go thru Central Entry by calling Gena at 509-962-6879. All the same WSHSRA entry rules will apply. Gena will then post the draw for the 2 events on the website and we will know in advance how many contestants will be at each shoot.

There will be 3 shoots, to be Eligible for Nationals you must compete in 2. We will then take your top 2 scores and determine the Top 4 and alternates in each event that can go on to Nationals.

Washington JR High members have been included. 22 Rifle Target is the only event available, there is NO Trap Shooting for JR High. Same rules apply. They will shoot first, so they can get back to rodeo grounds for their Friday night rodeos. If you are a JR High Member and want to compete, please enter at the appropriate times and days thru Central Entry.

PARENTS CANNOT GO BEYOND FIRING LINE.

Shooters **MUST** supply their own **GUNS, AMMO, and EYE & EAR PROTECTION** for both events. Targets, Trap and Empty Chamber Indicator's will be provided.

Rifles will be weighed in according to National rules and can be NO more than 8 ½ pounds total weight including sights. **Triggers must have NO less than a 2 lbs Pull**

22 Rifle will have 12 shots in each position – Prone, Standing & Kneeling, plus a 12 shot warm up



Trap will be 1 round of 25 Trap, plus a warm up
